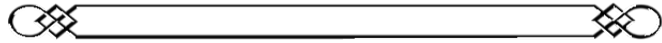

Council President Connections

The Church Council met on July 16, 2026.

The agenda included the following noteworthy items:

Pastoral Call Announcement. Great news! I am pleased to announce that the Call Committee and Church Council have both voted unanimously to recommend calling a pastoral candidate. At the request of the candidate and Synod office, we cannot disclose the name of the candidate at this time. A Special Congregation Meeting has been scheduled for August 9, 2026 at 10:00 a.m. for the congregation to vote on approving the call. We have scheduled a "Meet & Greet" event for August 8th from 4:30 to 5:30 p.m. to give church members an opportunity to meet the candidate before the vote.

2026 Ice Cream Social. The Ice Cream Social was a success! A big **THANK YOU** to everyone who helped. We served approximately 180 people. The net income from this year's event is \$1,576.88. The Church Council will decide at our August meeting how to allocate the income.

Loganville Parade Church Float.

Attention all walkers! We are still looking for a few more volunteers to carry the banner and hand out the giveaways for the Loganville Parade on August 22nd. Please let me know if you can help.

New Elevator Maintenance Agreement.

The Church Council approved a new elevator maintenance agreement with TK Elevator. The previous agreement included a service call every 3 months. At our request, the new agreement includes a service call every 2-1/2 month, which should result in

the elevator being more reliable. The cost for the new agreement is \$149.25 per month, which is an increase of \$25.33.

Brotherhood Mutual Church Insurance

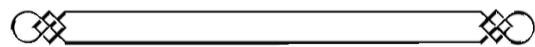
Renewal. The annual premium for property and general liability insurance has increased to \$9,872, which is a \$600, or 6.47% increase.

Concrete Sidewalk Replacement. The Church Council approved replacing a section of concrete sidewalk in front of the parsonage. The current sidewalk is uneven, which creates a tripping hazard.

Video Projector Replacement. The existing video projector in Fellowship Hall no longer works and needs to be replaced. The Church Council approved replacing the projector with new equipment as recommended by Bill Schuette.

St. Peter's Moments in History

In 1983 the church was made handicapped accessible with a new entryway sidewalk.

And in 1985 Erwin Thies was honored for 45 years of playing the organ.

In 1988 the American Lutheran Church merged with other synods and became the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, ELCA.

In 1990 a new constitution was adopted and a new parsonage was built. And in 1998 the new east addition to the church with an office and classrooms was completed.

In 2002 Internet service was installed in the church, and a year later the mortgage for the new east addition was burned. Ushering members out after services was discontinued.

In 2008 a new digital organ was installed in the church. In 2010 the women began a Prayer Shawl ministry.

A new carpet was installed in the basement in 2012. In 2014 the parsonage was remodeled and two artificial Christmas trees were used for the first time. Holy Communion would be celebrated every Sunday.

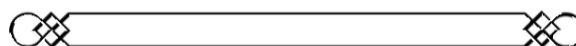

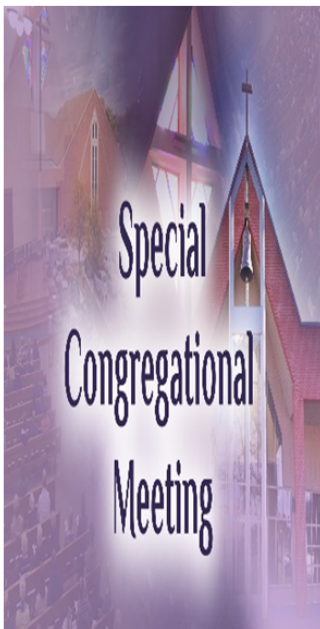

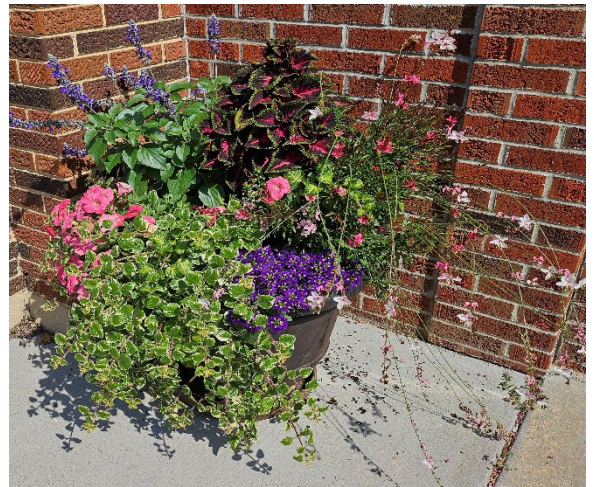
